What is UWC: “UWC (United World Colleges) it is a global educational movement that makes education a force to unite people, nations and cultures for peace and a sustainable future” Through this possibility, many of our CCB students previously, at the beginning of the 10th grade, have applied and have won scholarships to study in these colleges where they later graduate with 100% scholarships in the best universities in the world. As you have to prepare yourself in advance to have all the requirements ready, we are informing students that they are interested now about this superb opportunity.

Selection Criteria

- **Curiosity and intellectual motivation:** Genuine desire to learn about the world, about one's environment. Ability to recognize the details and breadth of different issues - for example: globality and local problems or needs, involved in any given issue - and to reach a level of deep and critical analysis of these.
- **Active Commitment:** Ability to be willing to reflect, question and confront personal values, one's own behavior within the family and the community based on their principles. Act under own criteria with responsibility and assume with commitment the realization and fulfillment of proposed projects.
- **Social Skills:** Ability and willingness to interact with other people with respect, to work as a team and to achieve solutions that promote harmony with others. Have the ability to express yourself in a pertinent and appropriate way with others, in different situations.
- **Resilience, personal responsibility and integrity:** Ability to take care of yourself physically and emotionally during the challenging and transformative experience that UWC offers. Have the personal motivation to assimilate the moral and ethical principles common in UWC, a sense of humility and the ability to listen and value the opinion of another person and to live the experience of solving or adjusting to difficult situations.
- **UWC Motivation:** Passion, skill and real incentives to contribute to promoting UWC's mission and values. Interest in sharing the experience with people of different cultures, religions and socioeconomic realities.


How to apply: After you have preregistered and paid the registration fee, you will receive a personalized email to access the application form. Both the pre-registration and the registration forms will be available in the same platform which will be opened on August 1st at 11:00 p.m. until October 20, 2021. ATTENTION: All the information provided by the candidates during the selection process must be truthful and will be subject to verification in accordance with the provisions of Article No. 83 of the National Constitution and Articles 286 to 296 of the Colombian Penal Code related to Falsehood. in Documents; Strictly comply with the requirements for this program and must send the required application documentation, on the deadline related to this call. Likewise, if any inconsistency or inconsistency is found between the requirements demanded in the call, the data recorded in the virtual form and the documentation provided in support of this request will be excluded from the process and there will be no right to claim. 9. Community Project to create "a better world": Keeping in mind UWC's mission "United World Colleges (UWC) make education a force to unite people, nations and cultures to work for peace and a sustainable future", you must design a community project plan that you would like to start or the one you are currently participating in, because you believe this project is necessary to create a better world and benefit your community. For the project plan it is necessary to take into account the following aspects:

- The title and explanation of the Project
- Your motivation and justification for suggesting this Project
- 3 clear and specific objectives that you want to achieve with the Project
- Explanation of the importance and impact of the project in your community
- Answer with a minimum of 200 words and a maximum of 300 words in total

10. Video

The following questions must be answered through a video of maximum 2 minutes. Include concrete examples. We are very interested in your creativity, but we are not evaluating your computer, digital or editing skills. 11. Required Documentation. Upload the necessary documentation in the following order:

- Two teaching references (see requirements for letter of recommendation)
- This year's academic reports
- The final academic report of the previous year
- UWC academic performance report (attached document)
- Parents' income statement
- Last receipt of salary payment from parents
- Employment letter from parents: specifying work time and salary
- The last bank statement of the parents
- Last receipt of payment from the school
- Public Service Monthly Invoice: Electricity, water, gas and cellular or fixed telephony
- Document with parental consent signatures (attached document)

¿How much does it cost to attend a UWC School?

The selection process is made based on merit and potential, not based on the financial capacity of each student. However, colleges have access to limited resources to support students who could not otherwise attend UWC Colleges. This financial aid can range from 5% to 100% of the cost of tuition but under no circumstances does it cover all costs. That is, regardless of the type of financial aid offered by each college, students have to collect funds locally to cover expenses such as passport, visa, and health insurance.

Financial aid is allocated directly by each college depending on the parents' income and funding from external sources available each year. It is also important to remember that not all applicants receive financial assistance and that each year spaces are offered to applicants who have been successful during the selection process and who are able to pay full tuition.

In all cases, students and their families assume the responsibility of paying the schools directly. Additionally, before the student travels to the respective school, the parents sign an agreement specifying their financial responsibilities with the organization and with the national committee.
