Overview: Bishop is a liberal arts university founded in 1843, as affiliated to Oxford University. It's 550-acre campus is located in the bilingual community of Lennoxville, a suburb of the city of Sherbrooke, Quebec, located about 1.5 hours southeast of Montreal. The university offers a nice residence life, dining, recreation & fitness, safety and security. It has seven residences, two libraries, two theatres, outstanding classrooms, laboratories, athletic facilities, a newly renovated sports and recreation centre that includes three gyms, an indoor pool and an 800-seat arena, a historic chapel, a music recital hall, and a daycare. A duck pond and wildlife refuge, an outdoor pool and a **golf course** are also found on the campus.

Faculty: Bishop's University boasts some of Canada's best university professors.

Admission process: To apply to Bishop's University, simply fill out the appropriate application form on our website. Applications for Fall entry generally open in early September and applications for Winter entry generally open in the spring or early summer.

Admission requirements: Completed IB Diploma, minimum predicted IB Diploma score of 30, not including EE/TOK bonus points. There are program-specific IB requirements.

IB Courses and Transfer Credit: Students can receive advanced standing credit at Bishop's University for most Higher Level IB courses completed with a score of 5 or better. **ATTENTION:** Students who complete the full IB Diploma with a final Diploma score of 30 or higher (not including EE/TOK bonus points) are eligible to receive 30 advanced standing credits, equivalent to one year of full-time study.

Required Supporting Documents: All Applicants

- English proficiency. TOEFL iBT score: 90 points or Duolingo: 115 points with no sub-score under 9
- High school transcript, with predicted IB results, including current mid-term grades if possible.
- While not required, teacher recommendations or personal statement may assist us when reviewing your application.
- Copy of passport identification page.
- Music applicants: audition and letter of musical background are required. Please refer to the **Music Admissions Information Sheet**.

ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

\$40,000 CAD that includes tuition, compulsory fees, accommodation, meals, books & supplies.

Scholarships, Awards, Bursaries: At Bishop's we have two main categories for all entering students: competitive admission scholarships; and our awards and bursaries.

Competitive Scholarships: Our scholarships range in value up to **\$20,000 CAD per academic year**. Some are renewable for your entire time at Bishop's (renewal conditions apply), while others are one-time awards that you can receive either as a new student or a continuing student. To be considered, all you need to do is complete your online application for admissions by **March 1st** and have all your supporting documents submitted to us no later than March 15th. We will then review all applicants and make scholarship offers soon thereafter.

Chancellor's Excellence Scholarship: **\$10,000 CAD per year** (renewable for up to three additional years or a total value of \$40,000), are intended to recognize and reward students with outstanding academic records who personify Bishop's fundamental values – sound learning, good citizenship, community, discovery, excellence, and sustainability.

Awards and Bursaries: Up to **8,000 per academic year**. Most of these awards and bursaries are one time non-renewable available to entering students only. To be considered, all you need to do is complete your online application for admissions and complete the online awards and bursaries application by March 1st. In addition to academic merit, these awards may also consider leadership, extra-curricular activities and financial need. The awards and bursaries form is available in December.

PROCEDURE: (only one application required)

1. Complete each section of the application form.
2. Describe your financial need and your situation as it applies to the criteria of the awards
3. Provide copies for proof of income for yourself and your parents. If you are in a unique situation and are not able to provide proof of parents/spouse, please detail your situation so the committee knows why you did not provide income proof.
4. Submit your online application by May 1, 2021 and scan proof of income documents by May 15, 2021 to: **businessoffice@ubishops.ca** – please send only 1 email with all supporting proof. Only complete applications with supporting documents will be considered. Recipients will be notified the week of August 15, 2021 via their BU email.
