Definitions to keep in mind:

Suspect Case:

- Student or staff member who presents symptoms associated with COVID-19 (body aches, extreme tiredness or fatigue, fever equal to or higher than 38°C, cough, difficulty breathing, loss of smell and/or taste, diarrhea, nasal congestion or secretion, sore throat, among others).
- Person awaiting a Covid - 19 test result for self or for a family member (living together).
- Person who has had close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 5 days.

Confirmed Positive Case:

- Student or staff member with laboratory confirmation by testing (PCR/Antigen) for COVID-19 infection, regardless of clinical signs and symptoms.

Close contact:

- Any exposed, unprotected person who who has shared a space of less than one metre and for at least 10 minutes with a person who has been diagnosed with Covid-19 regardless of whether or not he/she has symptoms.
- Any person with protected exposure (face mask) who has shared a space of less than one metre and for more than 2 hours, in a room without air circulation with a person who has a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19, regardless of whether or not they have symptoms.

Recovered case:

- Confirmed positive Student or Staff Member who on completion of 10 days of isolation and, during the last 72 hours (last 3 days of isolation), has had no fever without the use of antipyretics, no cough or respiratory distress.

Active case:

- Student or Staff Member who is still within their contagious period. It is the number of confirmed positive cases minus recovered cases.

Note:

1. For this report we have taken into account the data from the Daily Health Condition Survey filled out both by students and staff, information sent by parents or employees through e-mail and consultation reports done by CCB's Medical Department.
2. The data in this Health Report includes information from the periods of time starting on September 16 to September 30, 2021.
3. The 303 suspected cases of students and 14 reported cases of collaborators were preventively isolated for the corresponding medical assessment in order to clarify and certify the diagnosis and/or while the PCR/Antigen test was performed. In all cases the information provided was verified and it was guaranteed that they would not return to classes or face-to-face activities until the medical incapacity was complied with and a complete improvement of symptoms was achieved. COVID-19 infection was ruled out in all these cases.
4. Suspected cases of students were supported with virtual classes from the second day of reporting symptoms and during the period of preventive isolation.
5. In the period from 16 to 30 September, no positive cases of students or collaborators were reported.
6. The cases that were followed up because they were international travellers, were isolated for 10 days or provided evidence of a PCR test or negative antigen taken between the 3rd and 5th day of their return to the country to ensure their safe return to classes in alternation.
7. It is important to note that the Municipal Public Health Secretariat through Circular No. 4145.010.22.2.1020.023145 of September 20, reported some changes in the definition of suspected case and close contact in educational institutions, which were already adjusted in our biosecurity protocol. Similarly, they established that the isolation period for confirmed cases and close contacts is 10 days from the onset of symptoms.
8. The School depends on Parents' and Staff's commitment to inform and report suspected or confirmed cases in a timely manner and compliance with biosecurity protocols.
9. The definitions are based on the Guidelines, Orientations and Protocols to address COVID-19 in Colombia. Ministry of Health and Social Protection.
